BCC AT A GLANCE

GOLFING MEMBERSHIP

We are in a fortunate position that our Membership is currently full and as such we have closed our membership with a permanent waiting list for all membership categories.

NON-GOLFING / SPORT SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP

- Sport Social members enjoy access to the full Club offering excluding the golf course.
- Sport Social members are however able to play golf at Social Sports rates, during off peak periods.

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM

ENTRANCE FEE

- This once off fee is payable when you initially join the Club. Spouses and children of members do not pay an entrance fee.
- The fee is R23 500 for ALL new members 30 years and older.

ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTIONS

- Our financial year runs from 1st May to 30th April.
- Should you join during this period your annual subs will be pro-rated.
- Notice of fees due are sent out in February and are payable by 1st May.
- Monthly debit order facilities are available, kindly ask the admin office for a debit order form if you wish to pay monthly. This includes a 5% handling fee.
- These do not include handicap and affiliation fees.

MEMBERSHIP INDUCTION

Once your application is approved you will be invited to an induction meeting hosted by Andrew Rogers our GM, and will receive a welcome pack. You will be sent an invoice and once this is paid you will be entitled to start using your membership.

TOP UP VOUCHER

An amount of R1000 is payable for all members (excl. Honorary Life, Country, Absentee and Junior members). This amount will be loaded to your Levy account. You will have an opportunity to load funds onto your Top-Up account for cashless convenience in the club. Members receive 15% discount on food and 17% discount on beverages at the Club when making use of your top-up account! Kindly note that discount on alcohol does not apply to Junior Members.

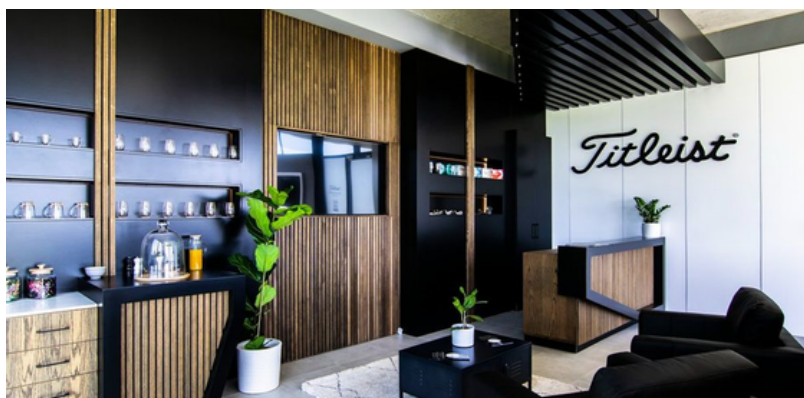

DRESS CODE

- Whilst our dress codes have been relaxed in line with modern standards, it remains important that some standards are maintained to uphold the traditions and prestige of the Club. It is essential that both Club Members and Visitors adhere to
- these regulations. Improperly dressed members or guests will be asked to change attire. Our golf professionals and golf shop staff will be happy to assist you or your guests with suitable clothing, which is available for purchase in the golf shop.
- The following rules apply:
- **GOLF:** Recognised golfing attire should be worn at all times. This excludes sweatpants, running attire, or tattered clothing. Shirts must be tucked in.
- **BOWLS:** Standard bowling attire (predominantly white) with regulation bowling footwear must be worn.



- **TENNIS/SQUASH:** Regulation attire (predominantly white) must be worn. Only regulation squash shoes are permitted (no black soles).
- **THE CLUBHOUSE:** A casual dress code is permitted, including sandals, shorts, and t-shirts, on the patio areas until sunset. After sunset, members and guests are requested to wear smart casual clothing. Hats should not be worn inside the Clubhouse.
- These regulations reflect the committee's interpretation of the wishes of the majority of members. Management reserves the right to exercise discretion and flexibility in interpreting the rules in relation to good taste and has the authority to ensure the rules are observed. Members are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure their guests comply with the Club's dress regulations.

KIDS PLAY AREA

The Club's focus on being family centric has attracted a lot of young families to the Club. BCC is complimented by 2 outdoor facilities for kids.

- Kids Play Areas – Important Policies
- To ensure a safe and enjoyable environment for all children, please take note of the following.
- Supervision & Responsibility
- Childminders provide general supervision only.
- The Kids' Club is not a babysitting or drop-off service.
- Parents/guardians must remain on the premises and be easily reachable at all times.
- Children remain the full responsibility of their parent/guardian at all times.

AGE POLICY

- The Kids' Club is open to children aged 12 years and under only.
- Children under 6 years must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times. Parents/guardians may not leave the area without their child.
- Children 6 years and older may use the facility under staff supervision; however, parents/guardians must still be easily reachable at all times.

KIDS EVENTS

- Various events are hosted for Children throughout the year! They are advertised in the newsletter and require bookings. Our annual Kids Easter Hunt, Sunset Concert and Halloween are some of the most popular events.

ACTIVITIES DURING THE HOLIDAY

- Various holiday clinics are on offer during the year, these will be advertised in the newsletter.

JUNIOR GOLF

- We offer complimentary Junior 9 Hole Golf for all BCC Golfing Juniors during the week after 15:00.
- Juniors are also encouraged to take advantage of the pre-paid junior card to get maximum value.
- A monthly junior competition is hosted on a Sunday, there is currently one junior league teams and we host free junior clinics every week. Further information is available from the Golf Director at golfdirector@bryanstoncc.co.za.
- Group junior lessons are often hosted by the Golf Academy during the week.

JUNIOR RACQUETS

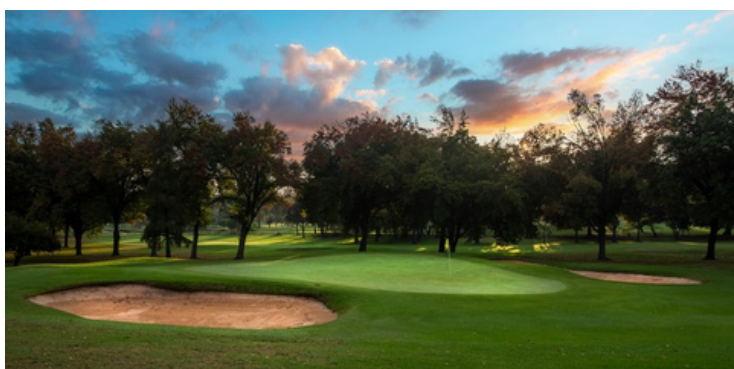
- Tennis: A complimentary junior tennis clinic is hosted every Saturday morning from 10:00 for juniors.
- Squash: We would love to see more Juniors on the squash courts and therefore offer a complimentary kids program with a professional squash coach once a week.

CURRENT MEMBERS TAKE NOTE

- A 30 % discount will apply to all partners of principal golfing members, across all categories of membership (with the 30% being deducted off the lower membership category). Example: Weekday Golfer and Social Member partner, the Social Member would get 30% discount. •
- Junior Sports Membership will be reserved for Junior Members whose parents are Members. We have unfortunately experienced some abuse of Junior Memberships by parents. Junior Members will no longer get free venue hire unless it is their own party and no discounts for alcoholic beverages.

GOLF

- As one of South Africa's finest golf clubs, the course is graced with undulating grounds and a wide variety of bird life. The immaculate grooming of the course almost diverts ones attention from the challenges of the 18-hole course. Held in high regard by the best golfers, it maintains a soft spot in the hearts of up-and-coming enthusiasts. The Course was designed by Charles H Alison in 1949 and was constructed by Koos de Beer over the next two years before opening in 1951. The Bryanston Country Club course plays to an unusual par 72 and is 6 768 metres long. It is a beautiful course with many water features coming into play on 11 of the holes. The Bryanston Country Club presents an exciting challenge where birdies are at a premium and hitting the fairways and the greens is an art to be mastered.



LADIES GOLF

- The BCC boasts a vibrant and active ladies section! Ladies with varied golfing ability are catered for with organized competitions and Trophy events together with social Wednesday and Friday mornings. A fun Friday competition is organized by the committee person on duty for the week and these are usually determined by the number of ladies playing on the day. Wednesday golf is a pre-arranged competition or trophy event. Ladies are encouraged to book at least one week in advance for Wednesday or Friday golf via the golf office as times for the ladies on these days are reserved. Saturday golf is organized by the Golf office and all full members are entitled to book and play in the competition on the day bookings open at 9am on the Friday a week prior to the Saturday.

GOLF ACADEMY, PRO SHOP AND FITMENT CENTRES

- The Bryanston Country Club Golf Academy and Pro Shop is situated in the heart of the beautiful Bryanston Country Club. The newly upgraded range include a hitting area; practice greens, chipping green and bunker facilities exclusive to Members. The academy is run by a team of qualified teaching PGA Pros and friendly staff. Our Pro Shop prides itself of being one of the finest on-course facilities. Members expect and receive excellent service with the finest golf paraphernalia. Titleist and My Golf Pro run world-class Club fitment facilities to help you take your game to the next level.

BOWLS

- Lawn bowls is an ideal way for people to develop their skills, co-ordination and fitness. Join the dynamic BCC bowls section, offering both a fun environment for social players as well as a more formal atmosphere for the competitive bowler.
