FROM FORMAL TO HIGHVELD

A concept garden trial between the 7th Green and 8th Tee Box

A softer, more naturalistic and distinctly South African landscape direction.



THE CHANGE AT A GLANCE

BEFORE



Existing formal planting

View from the 8th Tee Box looking back.

PROPOSED



Highveld-inspired concept

The same area reimagined with grasses, aloes and rocks.

THE PROPOSED DESIGN LANGUAGE

Grasses provide the canvas. Aloes provide the vertical rhythm. Rocks provide the structure.
A naturalistic Highveld interpretation, designed to sit comfortably alongside manicured lawn.

WHY ARE WE LOOKING AT THIS?

The Club is exploring a trial area where formal clipped hedges and rose beds can gradually give way to a more natural Highveld-inspired planting style.

The aim is not to redesign the gardens entirely, but to test a landscape approach that feels more connected to the golf course and its setting.



GRASSES

THE CANVAS

Indigenous veld grasses create movement, texture and seasonal change.



ALOES

THE VERTICAL RHYTHM

Placed selectively for sculptural form and seasonal colour.



ROCKS

THE STRUCTURE

Large, partly embedded rocks create the feel of a natural outcrop not a rockery.

WHAT MEMBERS SHOULD KNOW

- This is a carefully designed interpretation of the Highveld - not unmanaged veld.
- The selected area is a trial between the 7th Green and 8th Tee Box (approx. 130 m²).
- If successful, the design language could be selectively extended to other areas over time.

BCC TREE MANAGEMENT & REPLACEMENT PLAN

A long-term approach to protect our tree heritage, strengthen biodiversity and shape a resilient Highveld landscape for generations to come.



THE GOAL IS NOT TO REMOVE TREES FOR THE SAKE OF IT.

Healthy, established trees that add to the Club's character will be retained wherever possible.

WHY A MASTER PLAN?

- Planned succession, not reactive replacement.
- Improved biodiversity and wildlife habitat.
- Reduced long-term maintenance.
- A stronger Highveld identity.
- Better drought and climate resilience

WHAT WILL CHANGE?

- New planting will favour carefully selected indigenous species.
- Species will be matched to soil, moisture, space and course suitability.
- High-water-use or unsuitable trees may be replaced over time.
- Invasive species will be progressively controlled

WHAT WILL STAY?

- Healthy heritage trees wherever possible.
- Golf strategy and important views will remain central to decisions.
- Trees that provide shade, character and amenity
- Valuable mature Jacarandas, Oaks and Plane Trees.

Progress You Can See Across the Course

The Greens Project continues to progress well, with several major milestones reached over the past few weeks. The recent weather has been ideal for both spring treatment and the grow-in programme, and we are starting to see very encouraging results across the course.

Seeding & Sodding Progress

- Holes 12, 13, 14 and 15 have now been completed with seeding, together with the sodding of the surrounding areas.
- Holes 3, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 17 have been cut at 8mm and have also received a light top dressing.
- Holes 4 and 16 have germinated successfully, are progressing well on the grow-in programme, and have now received their first cut.
- Holes 1, 2, 10 and 11 have also germinated and are currently progressing through the grow-in programme.
- Holes 9 and 18 remain under construction and are on schedule to be completed by next week.

The putting green and stage area are scheduled to commence from 7 September, marking another important phase in the project.



Spring Treatment Underway

Spring treatment to the fairways and tees has now been completed. A light top dressing will also be applied across the playing areas as part of the seasonal programme.

The combination of warmer temps, improved growing conditions and the work being done by the team is helping us move steadily towards the next phase of course preparation.

Bunkers & Dam Works

All fairway bunker drainage has now been completed, with new sand installed.

- Work on Dam No. 2 is also progressing well. The wall has been completed and stonework will begin shortly.



- At Hole 14, the dam stone wall has now been completed.



These areas form an important part of the broader course improvements and are really beginning to change the overall look and feel of the course.

Preparing for the Course Ahead

One of the most encouraging parts of the project has been seeing the team respond positively to the changes taking place around them.

Staff morale remains good, and ongoing training is taking place to ensure that, once the project is complete, the team is fully prepared to maintain the course to the standard we are working towards. There is still plenty of work ahead, but with each week we are getting closer to seeing the full picture come together.

The progress is becoming more visible across the course, and the team remains focused on delivering a pristine new course for our members to enjoy.

Our new range balls have arrived, and we invite members to come down and experience them for themselves.

There is nothing quite like practising with a fresh bucket of balls, so whether you are fine-tuning your swing, warming up before a round or simply enjoying some time at the Range, come and give them a hit.

The ClubMaster Ball Dispenser continues to evolve, with new functionality being introduced.

The system will soon allow members' Club cards to synchronise with the ball dispenser. Once a prepaid package has been purchased and loaded onto your membership card, buckets will be able to be redeemed directly at the machine.

Current prepaid packages include:

Gold Package:

30 prepaid buckets of 60 balls - R1,650

Silver Package:

15 prepaid buckets of 60 balls - R900

Diamond Junior Package:

30 prepaid buckets of 60 balls - R750

Available to juniors only.

The final bucket is currently available from the dispenser at **18:00** daily. This time will be extended as daylight hours increase during summer.

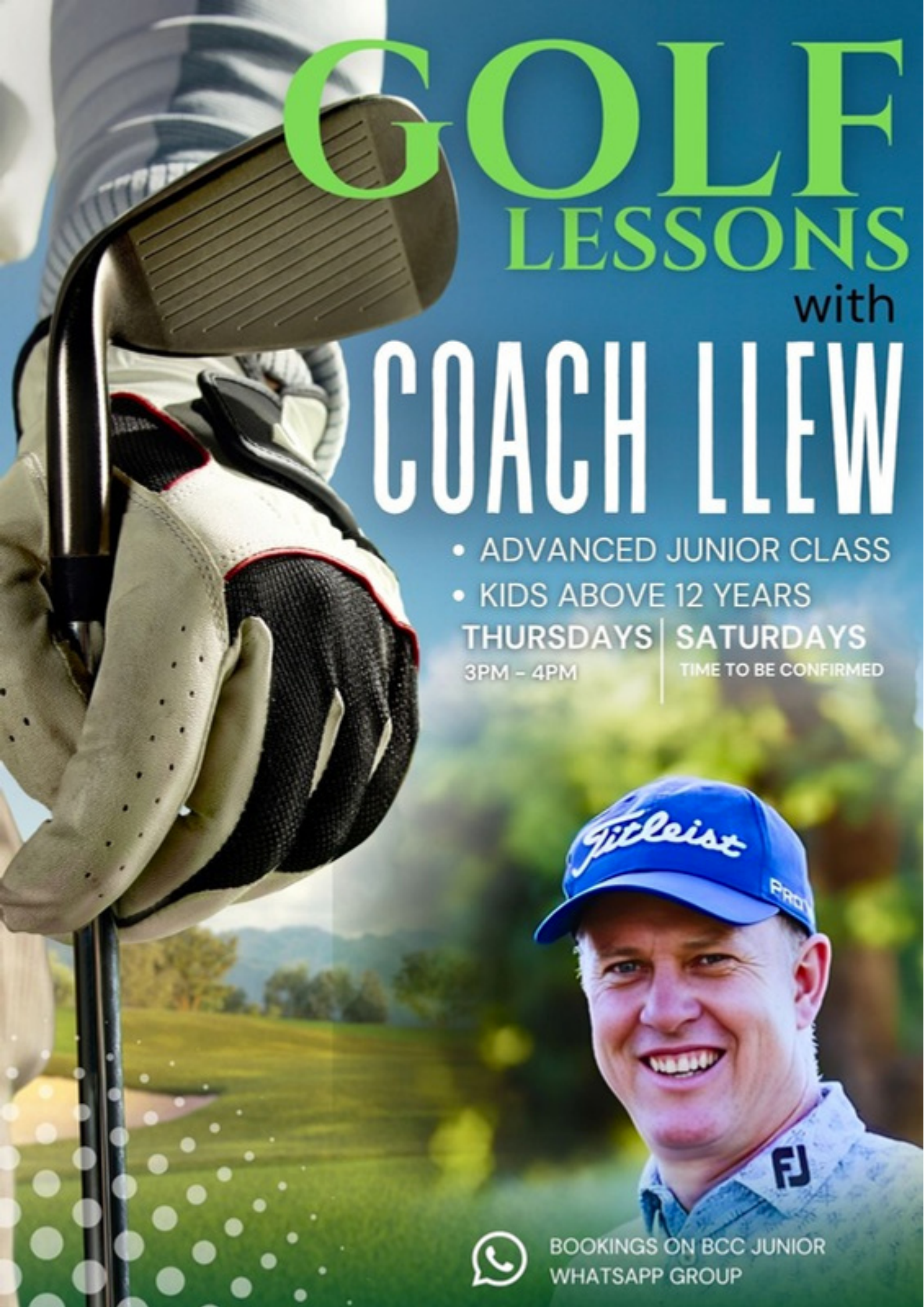

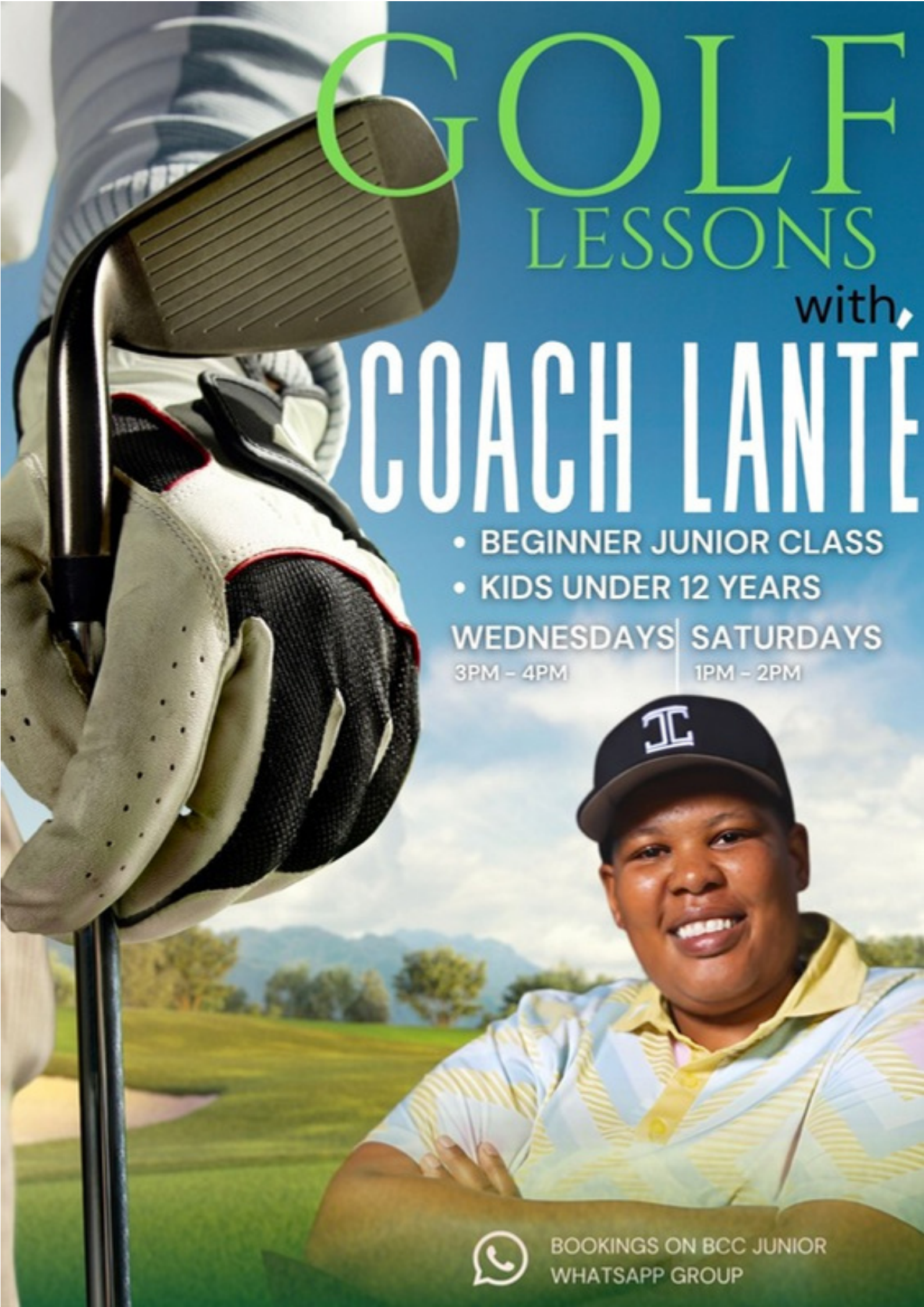

Choose Your Discomfort

Most of us spend a lot of our lives trying to avoid discomfort by holding on to what's familiar, even when the very thing we're holding on to is what's making us uncomfortable.

Being unhappy in your job is uncomfortable. Looking for a new one is uncomfortable.

Being unhappy in a relationship is uncomfortable. Having the difficult conversation is uncomfortable.

Feeling unfit and unhealthy is uncomfortable. Changing the way you eat and starting to exercise is uncomfortable.

Feeling stuck is uncomfortable. Changing is uncomfortable.

What if the idea that we should always be comfortable is actually what keeps us from growing? What if the secret to a great life isn't to avoid discomfort, but to choose the discomfort that's going to move you towards the life you want to live?

The discomfort of growth is different. It asks you to do things you haven't done before, have conversations you've been avoiding, risk getting something wrong, make decisions without knowing exactly how they'll turn out, and sometimes leave behind what you know without knowing exactly what will replace it.

None of that is going to feel comfortable, but neither is remaining somewhere you've already decided you don't want to be.

Perhaps getting comfortable with discomfort isn't about learning to enjoy it. It's about becoming more intentional about which discomfort you choose.

One keeps you where you are. The other has the possibility of taking you where you would love to be.



So the next time you find yourself avoiding something because it feels uncomfortable, perhaps the question is: "Will this discomfort take me towards the life I actually want to live?"

The life you want may be on the other side of something you're avoiding because you've already decided it will be uncomfortable.
